

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to confirm that the Hotel & Motel Trades Council, AFL-CIO (“HTC”) has authorized employees of HTC to lobby before New York State and the City of New York government effective upon signature and through December 31, 2016. It is understood that the services performed pursuant to this agreement, require periodic filings with the New York Commission on Public Integrity (“Commission”) and the Office of the City Clerk of New York City (“City Clerk”). As such, no lobbying services will be performed by HTC until the proper documentation has been filed with the Commission and the City Clerk.

We anticipate that compensation paid to the HTC employees who will render such lobbying services will exceed the \$5,000.00 threshold.
